**BRIDGETON**



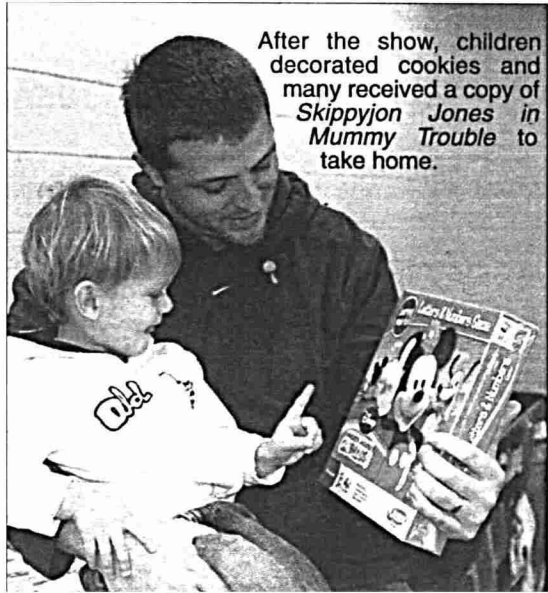
