

Carteret Library Receives Grant

CARTERET—The New Jersey State Parent Information and Resource Center (NJPIRC), a program of Prevent Child Abuse – New Jersey, recently awarded grants to 15 public libraries which will allow them to purchase books and educational materials that will enable parents to be effectively promoting in their children's learning and educational success.

The Carteret Public Library received \$2,500 to establish a collection on parent involvement in education. The library's new collection of 114 books and videos is temporarily located in a special display directly as you enter the library.

Last year, the library hosted an event with Joan Buzick, author and composer of the audio book "What Went Right Today". She presented a multimedia event to the audience explaining how to focus on the positive experiences each day brings. She also read and sang passages from the book as part of the presentation.

Carteret Library will also continue to work with Prevent Child Abuse throughout the year by participating in Child Abuse Prevention Month Activities
