Motorcycle Run
to prevent
child abuse**

BIKERS ACROSS NEW Jersey will unite to participate in a statewide motorcycle run on Saturday, June 13, escorted by the NJ State Police to benefit child abuse prevention and join thousands of motorcyclists across the nation in honor of a 2-year-old child who was murdered and raped.

The Katelynn Stinnett Memorial Run will start bikers at four points in Ledgewood, Lakewood, Burlington and Highland Park for a "kick-stands up" launch at noon and meet at Docks Corner Tavern in Monroe Township for an afternoon barbecue.

Katelynn was a toddler from Kentucky whose death touched the hearts of the nation's biker community who inspired nationwide groups to coordinate events in all 50 states.
