**Motorcycle Run  
to prevent child abuse**

**BIKERS ACROSS NEW** Jersey will participate in a statewide motorcycle run on Saturday, June 13, escorted by the New Jersey State Police, to benefit child-abuse prevention. The run is one of many across the nation in honor of a 2-year-old child who was murdered and raped.

The Katelynn Stinnett Memorial Run will start at four points in Ledgewood, Lakewood, Burlington and Highland Park for a "kick-stands up" launch at noon and meet at Docks Corner Tavern in Monroe Township for an afternoon barbecue.

Katelynn was a toddler from Kentucky whose death inspired nationwide biker groups to coordinate events. New Jersey bikers will ride to benefit Prevent Child Abuse-New Jersey.
