

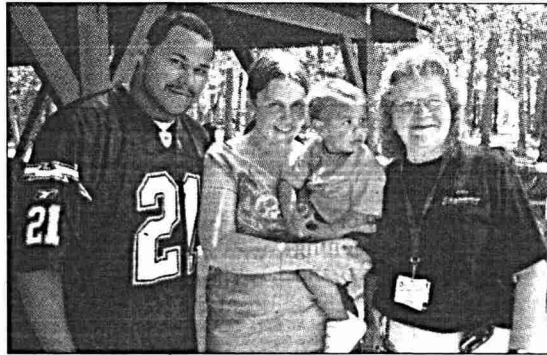
## Healthy Families Graduation Held at County Park June 8
