Call for Presenters at Conference for Professionals Supporting Families across NJ

New Brunswick, NJ- Prevent Child Abuse – New Jersey has released a call for workshop presenters to provide professional education and skill-building sessions for 350 family workers, home visitors, supervisors and teen parents who will attend a conference held at the Ocean Place Spa & Resort in Long Branch, NJ on May 9, 2011. The 9th annual conference, entitled "Strengthening Those Who Touch the Lives of Children", will gather the men and women working in prevention programs across New Jersey. Conference workshops are intensive sessions that will emphasize skill building and audience participation. Abstracts are requested for 75 minute workshops on issues of concern to professionals in education, law, juvenile justice, medicine, mental health, child protection, prevention, and domestic violence. PCA-NJ encourages interested presenters to submit proposals on a variety of topics related to all aspects of prevention of child abuse and neglect, including physical, sexual and emotional abuse and neglect. Suggested topics include child development, parent education, prevention programming, working with diverse families, domestic violence, and innovative investigative, intervention, treatment, and prevention models. The submission deadline is January 28, 2011.
