GENERAL INFORMATION

Prevent Child Abuse-New Jersey is seeking Experts in specific career fields for its Annual Teen Conference, which will be held on **May 2, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at The Forsgate Country Club in Monroe Township**, **NJ**. This annual conference brings together adolescent parents who participate in the Parent Linking Program (PLP) statewide. This program helps to assist young parents in keeping their commitment to complete high school as well as learning to fulfill their important role as parents. Our goal is to empower and educate the participants to continue on the path to success. We are seeking experts in these fields to share their expertise with teens who are interested in pursuing similar career paths.

AUDIENCE

The audience includes 150-200 male and female expectant and parenting adolescents who participate in the Parent Linking Program. Each session will be limited to 50 participants or less.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Applicants will be expected to participate in a 45 minute career information session
- Experts in the field <u>must</u>:
 - 1. Possess a minimum of 7 years of experience in one of the fields listed above
 - 2. Be willing and able to answer on the spot questions from teens
 - 3. Be willing and able to share the platform with 1-2 additional professionals in the same field.
 - 4. Be comfortable with interacting with adolescents
 - 5. Be comfortable speaking in public
- Personal experience as a young parent is a plus

- Proposals must be received by February 2, 2018.
- Selected applicants will be notified by e-mail of their acceptance by February 15th.
