

Higher Education Book Scholarship Instructions

Funded by the New Jersey Department of Children and Families

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria:

Any student applying for the Higher Education Book Scholarship is expected to meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating senior at a participating Parent Linking Program
- Have 75% participation rate or higher in Group Sessions
- Have an average GPA of 3.0 (B) or better in their senior year
- Be accepted to a community college, university or higher education program

Application Instructions:

- Complete the PLP Higher Education Book Scholarship Online Application: <u>https://pcanj.wufoo.com/forms/z102adcs1g0o1tp/</u>
- Submit an official high school transcript (NOT report card)
- Submit a "Letter of Recommendation" from a teacher or guidance counselor. You must inform the person completing your letter of recommendation to include the following:
 - ✓ Describe your character
 - ✓ Describe your commitment to educational pursuits
 - ✓ Why he/she believes you are deserving of the scholarship
 - Submit a college acceptance letter from the school you will attend.
- Complete an essay choosing ONE of the topics below. Essays must typed and a minimum of 1 page in length (maximum of 3 pages) double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point font.
- Submit a completed W-9 form (this is a requirement to receive a check from a non-profit agency). You must complete the following sections:
 - ✓ Name
 - ✓ Address
 - ✓ Social security number

All application materials can be uploaded with the online application. Alternately, materials can be emailed to KOliveira@preventchildabusenj.org. Submissions will receive a confirmation email of what has been received. All required materials must be received by the April 15th deadline. Mailed or faxed applications will not be considered at this time. We suggest that you keep copies of your application materials.

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the PLP Annual Teen Conference on May 17, 2022.

Essay Topic Options: Please choose one essay question to answer.

- 1. The theme of this year's Teen Conference is **Celebrating You**. Write about a success or accomplishment in your life. In your essay, tell us about the struggles and obstacles you overcame in order to achieve success.
- 2. The theme of this year's Teen Conference is Celebrating You. What is a character trait of yours that you celebrate? How will this trait help you succeed in college and beyond? Within your essay, describe this character trait, how it shows up in your life already, and how it will make you successful while you are in college.
